In addition to the merits of the new proposal, reviewers will be asked to evaluate whether expected outcomes from the previous award were met and whether significant progress has been achieved.

In Part 2, clusters are asked to provide specific metrics associated with their actual outcomes. Clusters are not expected to complete every field in every section of Part 2.
